NEWC Wildlife Rehabilitation Methods Course

6:30 - 9:00 PM September 11 – November 20

This ten-session course will be held every Monday with the exception of Columbus Day (October 9).

The Rehabilitation Methods Course will cover the material needed to successfully care for and release animals back to the wild. We will cover the natural history, medical techniques, nutrition, ethics, housing and husbandry, release criteria, euthanasia, wound care, and feeding included in the State exam.

This course includes both classroom and hands-on sessions, and is hosted in the Thomas E. Curtis Wildlife Education and Wildlife Hospital.

State Exam (Date to be announced): The Massachusetts State Wildlife Rehabilitators exam will be proctored at our facility at the conclusion of the course. This exam is offered free to those who participated in our course.
