## **NEWC Wildlife Rehabilitation Methods Course**

Mondays 6:30 - 9:00 PM September 9, 2019 – November 11, 2019

This ten-session course will be held every Monday. The Rehabilitation Methods Course will cover the material needed to successfully care for and release animals back to the wild. We will cover the natural history, medical techniques, nutrition, ethics, housing and husbandry, release criteria, euthanasia, wound care, feeding, and medical techniques included in the state exam. This course includes both classroom and hands-on sessions, and is hosted in the Thomas E. Curtis Wildlife Hospital at New England Wildlife Center.

There will be a review class on November 18<sup>th</sup> (6:30 – 9:00 PM) for preparation for the state exam.

**State Exam (Date to be announced):** The Massachusetts State Wildlife Rehabilitators exam will be proctored by the Massachusetts Division of Fisheries and Wildlife at our facility at the conclusion of the course. The actual date of the exam will be announced at the last class. This exam is offered free to those who participated in our course.
